February 8	AEEA adopts Elections Timeline.
February 8	Declaration of Candidacy forms & elections information available online @ www.aeea4u.org
February 8	Election Season Reminder sent to Membership.
March 2	AEEA Officers (President and Vice President), Directors (2 seats), NEA-RA Local Delegates (6 seats) and CTA State Council Alternate (1 seat) Declaration of Candidacy and Candidate Statements are due via email by 4:00 pm. Declarations received after 4:00 pm will not be accepted or valid. Declaration of Candidacy and Candidate Statements must be emailed to dknapp.ae@gmail.com .
March 11	AEEA candidate statements available online at http://www.aeea4u.org/
March 11	AEEA ballots and voting materials prepared
TBD	NEA-RA State Delegates voting takes place. CTA will oversee this election.
March 12-29	Voting for AEEA Officers, Directors, NEA-RA Local Delegates and CTA State Council Alternate takes place. Ballots will be mailed to members' home addresses on or before March 12, 2021.
March 29	Completed ballots must be post marked by USPS no later than March 29, 2021.
March 31	Counting of AEEA Officers, Directors, NEA-RA Local Delegates and CTA State Council Alternate ballots by the Elections Committee (Candidates are allowed 1 observer.) AEEA Elections Committee reports election results to the President. Any necessary run-off(s) will be determined.
April 23	Run-off materials for Officers prepared.
April 26 - May 7	Runoff voting for Officers, Directors and CTA State Council Alternate Run-offs take place at sites or by US mail.

May 7	Run-off election materials are due to AE office by 4:00 pm. Election materials received after 4:00 will not be counted. <i>(Do not use District mail after am Tuesday, May 4. If used, mail in ballots must be present by 4:00 pm.) If voting by mail is required, completed ballots must be postmarked by USPS no later than May 7, 2021.</i>
May 14	<i>Challenge to Officers, Directors and CTA State Council Alternate Run-off(s) will be determined.</i>
May 19	Counting of run-off ballots by the Elections Committee (Candidates are allowed 1 observer.) AEEA Elections Committee reports run-off results to the President.
May 21	Challenge to run-off elections due via email dknapp.ae@gmail.com by 4:00 pm.
Note	Nominations and voting for AEEA 2021-2022 Site Reps dates to be determined at each site. <i>(Site Rep nominations shall be open to everyone and voting shall be by secret ballot. Current Site Reps shall not conduct the election.)</i>
Reminders	Contract Ratification elections and any other Special Election(s) dates TBD based on need and date(s) of occurrence. There are three ways members on eave of absence can vote: Voting at her/his School Site, at the Anaheim Educators office or by requesting election materials be sent to her/his home
